MINUTES OF WOODLAND PTO MEETING WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 13, 2017

PTO AGENDA ITEMS

The PTO meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM by Lauren Wishnia.

MR. HEANEY -

CHANGE IN TEACHER LIAISON – Mrs. Leonard will be the new PTO Teacher Liaison taking the place of Mrs. Brower.

PARCC PERFORMANCE – Mr. Heaney reviewed Woodland's and the District's performance on PARCC testing for 2016-2017 School year and explained that we are overall well above the State and National average with our scores. NJASK SCIENCE - Additionally, Mr. Heaney discussed the results of the NJASK Science testing taken by Grade 4 students and noted that at Woodland 98% of students received Advanced Proficient or Proficient scores of that group 70% fell in the Advanced Proficient Category and 8 Students received perfect scores on this test.

This year both tests will be administered during the month of May.

ACTIVE LEARNING SPACES - Mr. Heaney discussed the introduction of "Active Learning Spaces" – classrooms with different styles of furniture than traditional classrooms that hope to improve the mindbody connection. A pilot program to test out this "re-imagined classroom environment" has been installed 1 classroom per school. Furniture items include "mushroom type stools", low tables and collaborative items. Woodland hopes to use Scholastic dollars to fund some additional furniture in the future.

THIRD GRADE TIMELINE PROJECT: Third graders are currently working on a timeline of the history of Woodland School which will be installed in the "west wing". Currently research and learning toward this goal in process.
